After that, people donated tons of food. The way it worked was that in every classroom there was a crate and people donated bags of food. We also had crates in the school office where people donated even more.

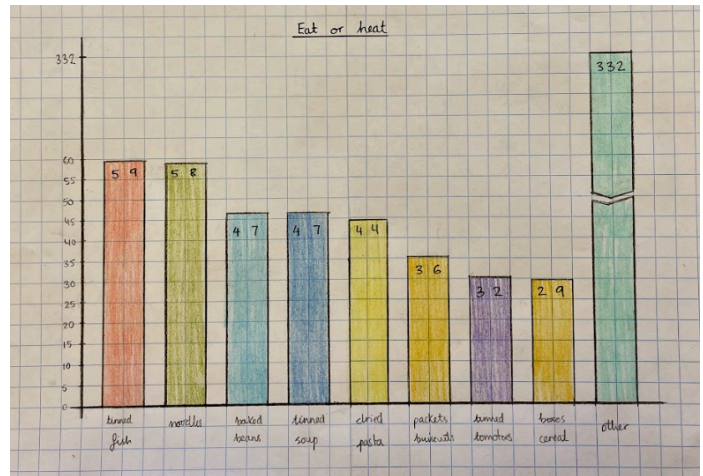




Following that, we made a document and counted each product and put it into tally charts. We sorted it into different categories. We almost got 800 different items!
